

Text 3: The Verse Account

Introduction

The Verse Account is another Babylonian document which describes the reign of Nabonidus. Although written in the same language as the Nabonidus Chronicle, it is very different in style. The identity of the person who produced the source is unclear, although it was evidently written at some time during the reign of Cyrus; it is also unclear why the document is written or where it was circulated. One suspects, however, that the document was composed by a Babylonian priest, angered by Nabonidus' meddling in religious affairs and with an axe to grind; alternatively, it might be part of an attempt to blacken Nabonidus' name by Cyrus (aided by a few Babylonian collaborators).
